



International 2.4m Regatta Weather Forecast

Weather Synopsis Summary for NYC Venue: Sept. 30th 2014 Issued @ 7:30am

Today: Radar is indicating scattered shower entering the race area around 8 am, these light scattered showers should end early this afternoon. The day will average mainly cloudy for most of the day, expect a slow clearing late this afternoon. Shoreline fog and mist will begin to dissipate by mid-morning. High temperature 22 C. Low tonight near 14 C with a clearing sky continuing.

Winds:

Winds will begin light this morning, but begin to increase around 10-11am as a weak cold front crosses the area. Winds will start off light and variable early this morning 2- 4 knots, beginning to build by mid-morning to NE 6 to 8, then increase 9 to 12 knots, with a few higher gusts this afternoon out of the E-NE to. The air will fill in from eastern section of the lake to western sections as the day progresses.
