2.4mR & 2.4 NOD IDENTIFICATION ON SAILS

Background

Identification on sails is controlled by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Class Rules.

Sails are being manufactured with black national letters and sail numbers on black sails which does not comply with the RRS specification that they be "of a contrasting colour to the body of the sail".

So comply with the RRS and make the letters and numbers clearly legible so Race Committees can easily identify your boat.

The 2.4mR class insignia is specified as **blue** under the class rules.

Appendix G IDENTIFICATION ON SAILS

- **G1.2** Specifications
 - (a) National letters and sail numbers shall be:
 - (1) in capital letters and Arabic numerals,
 - (2) of the same colour,
 - (3) of a contrasting colour to the body of the sail, and
 - (4) of a sans-serif typeface.

In addition, the letters and numbers identifying the boat shall be clearly legible when the sail is set.

The class insignia shall be in blue colour. Current and former champions may have the horizontal line in the insignia in a different colour:
